

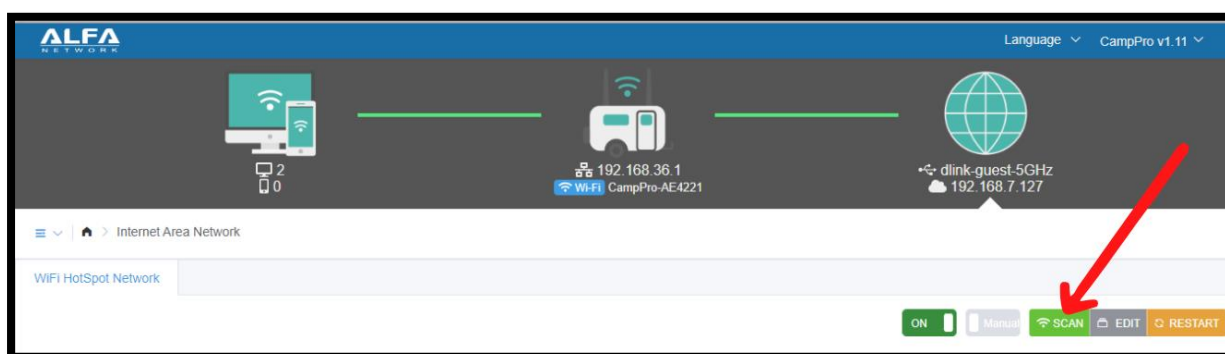
# How to Lock the MAC Address on Your ALFA Wi-Fi Camp Pro 3

\*\*\* Locking the MAC address is useful for those who may have multiple WiFi networks around them with the same SSID. This feature allows your Wi-Fi Camp Pro 3 to lock in on one of those signals based on the MAC address, rather than the SSID causing the device to become confused and jump between multiple connections. \*\*\*

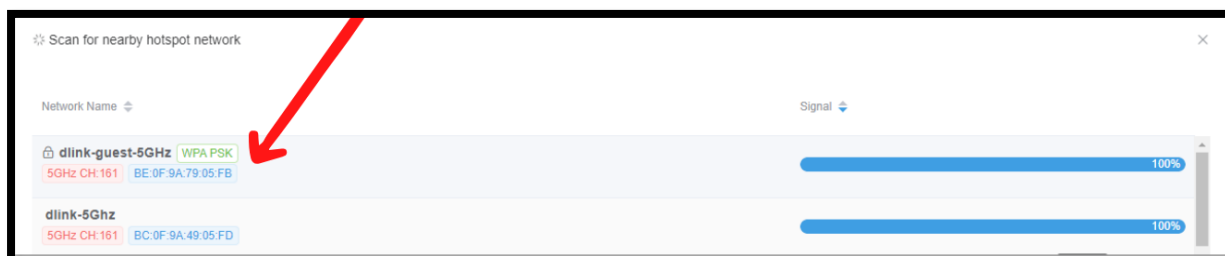
**Pre-Step1:** Ensure your devices hardware is properly secured at all connection points and that your setup device is connected to your CampPro's WiFi. Login to your CampPro router by typing 192.168.36.1 into the address bar of your favorite browser.

\*\*\* If you have already selected a network to extend, skip to Step 4. \*\*\*

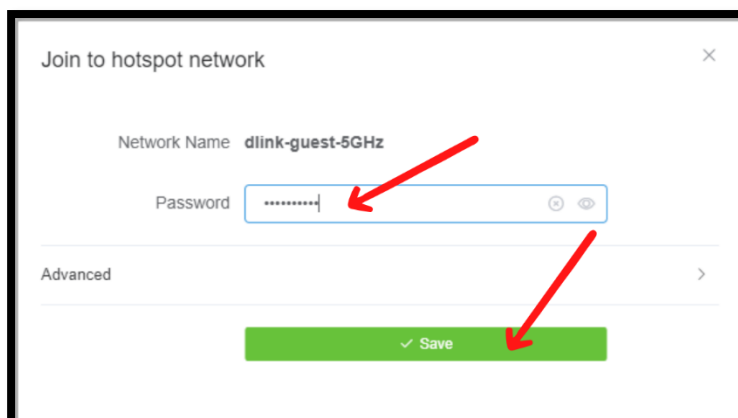
**Step 1:** Click the green scan button.



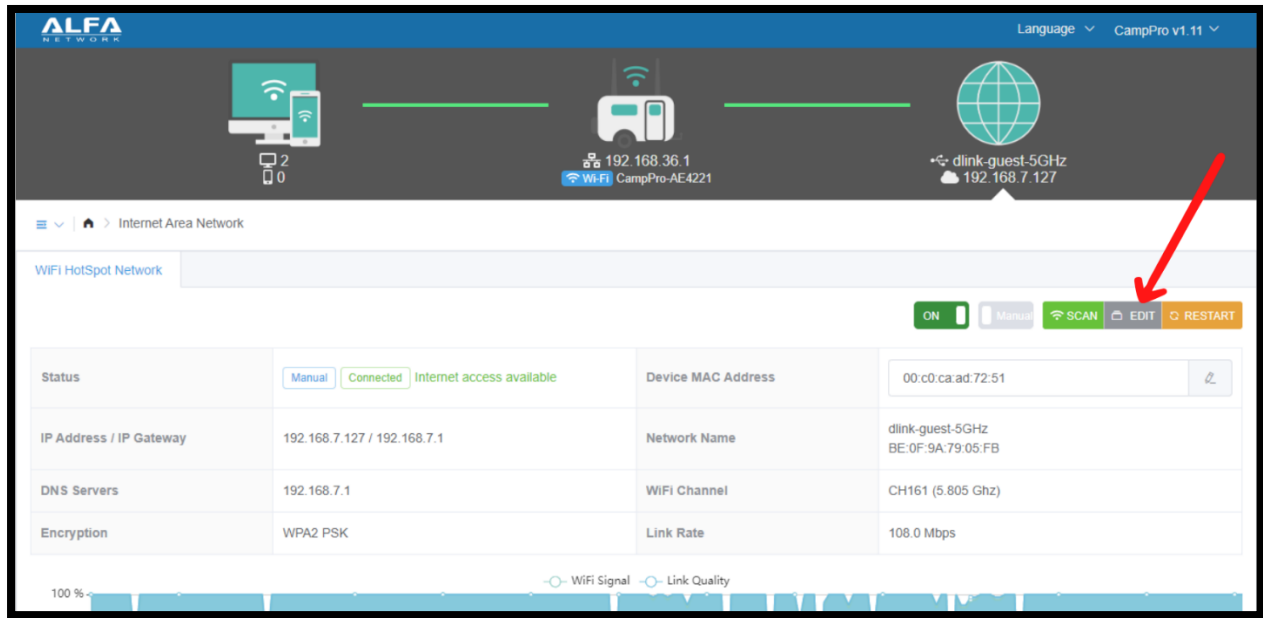
**Step 2:** Select the network you wish to extend.



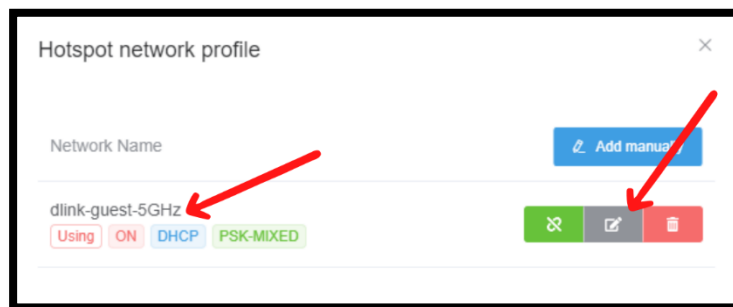
**Step 3:** Type in the network's password and click save.



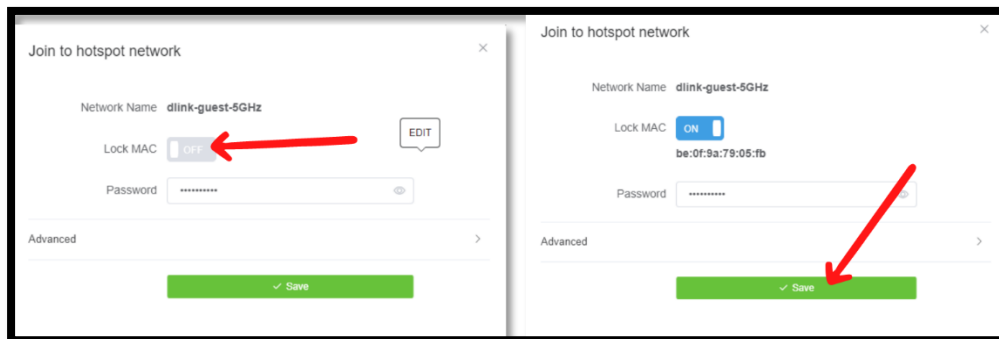
**Step 4:** At the router interfaces homescreen click the grey edit button.



**Step 5:** Browse the profiles and find the one that matches your current wireless extension, then click the grey edit button.



**Step 6:** Toggle the Lock MAC from OFF to ON and click the green Save button.



Wait for your device's settings to adjust and then continue your network usage as usual.
